Overview

A framework for embedding strategic thinking into regular operating routines — decision-making, resource allocation, weekly reviews — so strategy execution happens continuously rather than being confined to the annual planning cycle.

How is this different from the CEO & Executive Team Strategy

Operating Rhythm Playbook? That playbook designs the executive team's own meeting cadence. This one goes a level deeper — embedding strategic thinking into how individual teams and managers make everyday decisions, budget requests, and priority calls, not just the executive forums.

Won't this slow down day-to-day decision-making?

Done well, it speeds decisions up — teams stop escalating decisions that a clear strategic filter would let them make themselves, and stop pursuing initiatives that a quick strategic check would have ruled out early.
