Overview

A framework for building data literacy within public sector and smart city program teams — representativeness and equity assessment in civic data, public accountability reporting integrity, and appropriate privacy-aware data use — addressing the specific stakes of public sector data informing decisions that affect entire communities, including populations underrepresented in the data itself.

Public sector data decisions affect entire communities, including residents who may not be well-represented in digital or civic data sources (due to limited internet access, distrust of government data collection, or other barriers), raising representativeness and equity considerations that most private sector data literacy frameworks don't specifically address.
