Overview

A framework for building data-savvy meeting and decision-making rituals into leadership team practice — structured data review formats, explicit uncertainty discussion, and decision-quality retrospectives — since data literacy improvement requires changed team practice, not just individual leader capability building.

If individual leaders build strong data literacy, doesn't team

decision-making automatically improve? Not automatically — individual literacy helps, but without deliberate team rituals (structured data review formats, explicit uncertainty discussion norms), a leadership team can still default to intuition- driven discussion or superficial dashboard glancing regardless of individual members' underlying data literacy.
