Overview

A framework for building data literacy specifically for stakeholders evaluating and adopting cloud and data platform technology — vendor benchmark skepticism, total cost of ownership modeling, and appropriately weighing vendor-provided performance claims against your organization's actual workload characteristics.

Vendor-provided benchmarks and case studies seem like useful

decision inputs — what's the data literacy concern? Vendor benchmarks are typically constructed under conditions favorable to the vendor's product, and case studies are selectively chosen success stories — useful as inputs, but genuine literacy means recognizing these limitations and validating claims against your organization's actual workload characteristics rather than accepting them at face value.
