Overview

A framework for building data literacy specifically around sustainability metrics and climate risk analysis — climate model uncertainty interpretation, scenario-based thinking, and appropriately communicating climate risk projections to business stakeholders without false precision or false reassurance.

Climate risk models seem highly technical — is deep climate

science expertise necessary to use them for business decisions? Deep climate science expertise isn't required, but genuine literacy about how to interpret model uncertainty ranges and scenario-based outputs is essential — treating a climate projection as a single precise prediction, rather than understanding it as one scenario among a plausible range, is a common and consequential misinterpretation.
